The Sidi family is settling into Calgary and Canadian life. They are learning to navigate the city and shop for necessities. Medical, dental and optometry needs have been addressed. Fun outings to parks with playgrounds for Jala and a trip to the Zoo, all on mild winter days, have shown them that enjoyable life in winter is possible. After the frigid blast of late December and early January passed, Abde even said "Oh it's nice today. Only -10."

They are attending church at Bow Valley regularly and making friends in the process. They've enjoyed lunches, hiking trips and coffee with BVCC family. Thank you to all who have reached out to them in friendship.

Rangin started English classes in mid April. She is eager to learn English so that she can communicate more easily with new found friends. But Google translate and body language work amazingly well, so don't be afraid to approach her and start a conversation. Abde started English classes in May. While his English is good, and conversation with him is easy, he does want to improve his English in order to pursue a professional career.

They are wanting to buy a used car. If you have a used car in good repair that you are ready to sell, or know of someone who does, please talk to Abde or someone on the Refugee Sponsorship team.

Remember, we are their stepping stones to becoming fully integrated into Canadian life. This involves building friendships, having conversations to help with language development, explaining and modeling the customs and culture of Canada. We are co-sponsoring the refugee applications of Jamal's immediate family and cousin with him and his aunts who live in Calgary. Jamal, a young man originally from Syria, was the first refugee Bow Valley sponsored. He arrived in Canada in 2019 and has done very well for himself. He is currently enrolled in university to finish his degree.

The applications for these family members have been submitted and are in the earliest stages. We anticipate a 2 to 3 year wait before their arrival.

Financial Update

Ongoing donations to bring us back up to the required amount are greatly appreciated.
